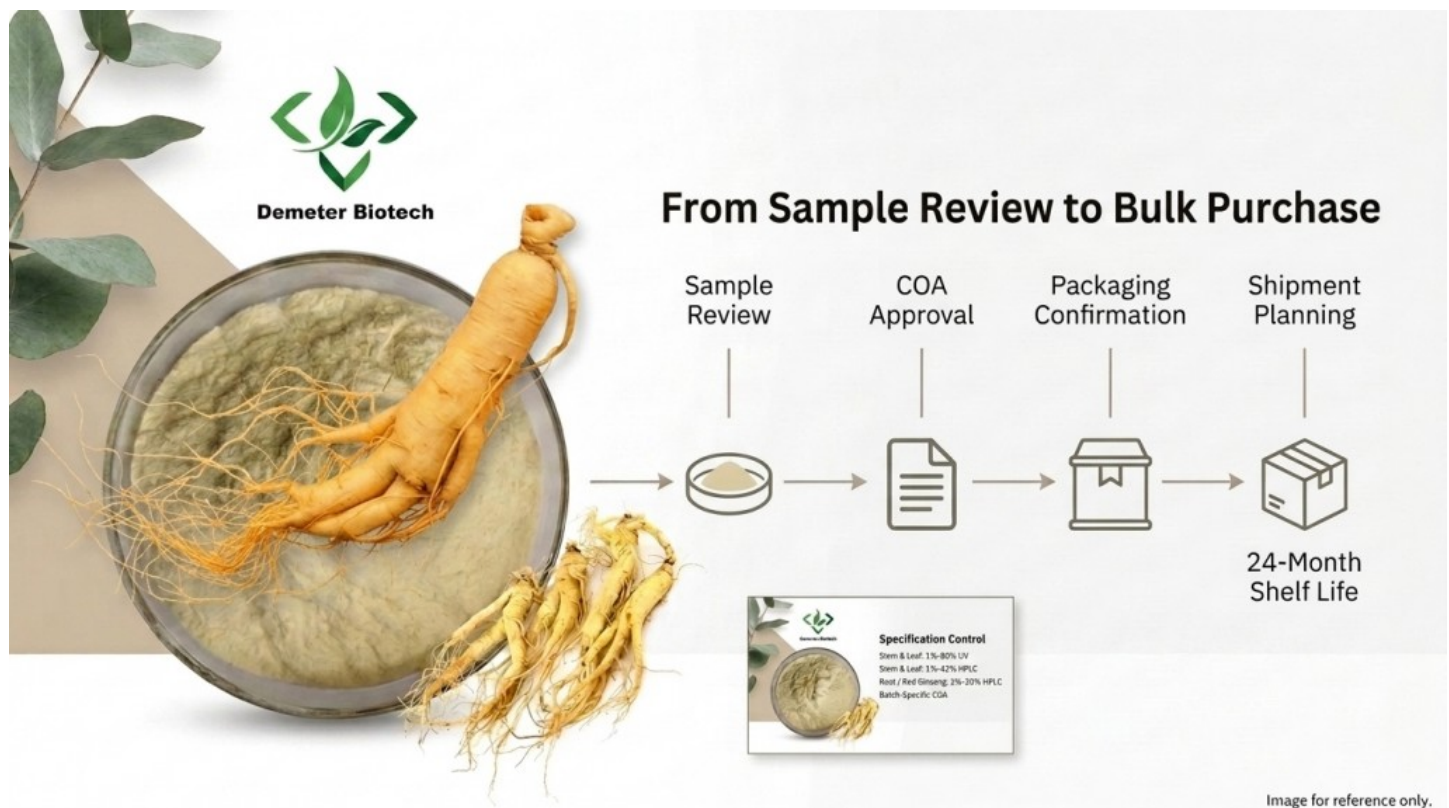

COA, Packaging, And Shelf-Life Data Convert Samples into Purchase Specifications

Samples become purchase specifications only when the accompanying documents and logistics details are fixed at the same time. Demeterherb provides free samples and certificates of analysis, enabling buyers to compare appearance, identity, active content, and analytical results before approving a commercial order. A 24-month shelf life gives inventory planners a defined basis for shipment timing, warehouse rotation, and replenishment schedules.

Packaging options support both evaluation and scale-up. The available formats include a 1 kg aluminum

foil bag, a 25 kg carton with an internal foil bag, and a 25 kg fiber drum. Those choices affect freight density, handling, moisture protection, and batch allocation across production sites. The most reliable sequence is sample review, COA approval, packaging confirmation, shipment planning, and commercial release. Ginseng raw powder can also be developed for capsules, tablets, and confectionery formats; ginseng extracts can be used in drinks and syrups; and ginseng polysaccharides can be used in supplement and beverage formulations.

Export infrastructure reduces friction when one ingredient must move through different regulatory, packaging, and delivery environments. A Procurement Checklist Keeps Ginseng Sourcing Auditable

An auditable ginseng order begins with a short but complete procurement checklist. Buyers should fix the species, plant part, ginsenoside percentage, HPLC or UV method, organic status where applicable, sample result, COA, packaging format, storage conditions, shelf life, quantity, and shipment mode. Every item should appear consistently across the quotation, specification sheet, batch documents, and purchase order.

This checklist changes the sourcing question from 'Who offers ginseng extract?' to 'Which supplier can reproduce the approved identity and active specification at commercial scale?'
