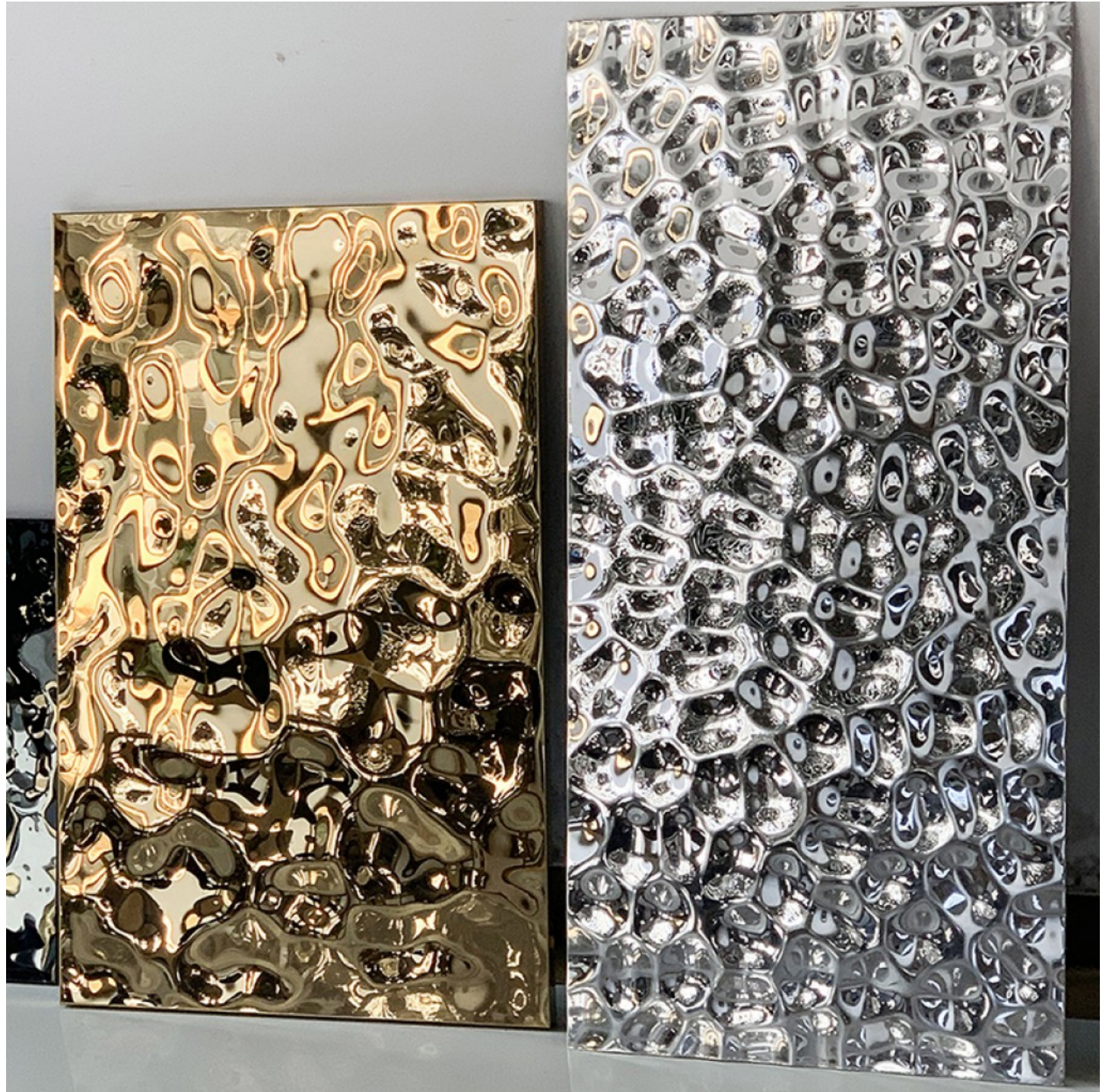

The integration of PVD (Physical Vapor Deposition) coating—allowing for Rose Gold, Black Titanium, and Champagne hues—was a major talking point at Stainless Steel World Asia. This allows the steel to mimic precious metals while retaining the structural integrity of steel.
