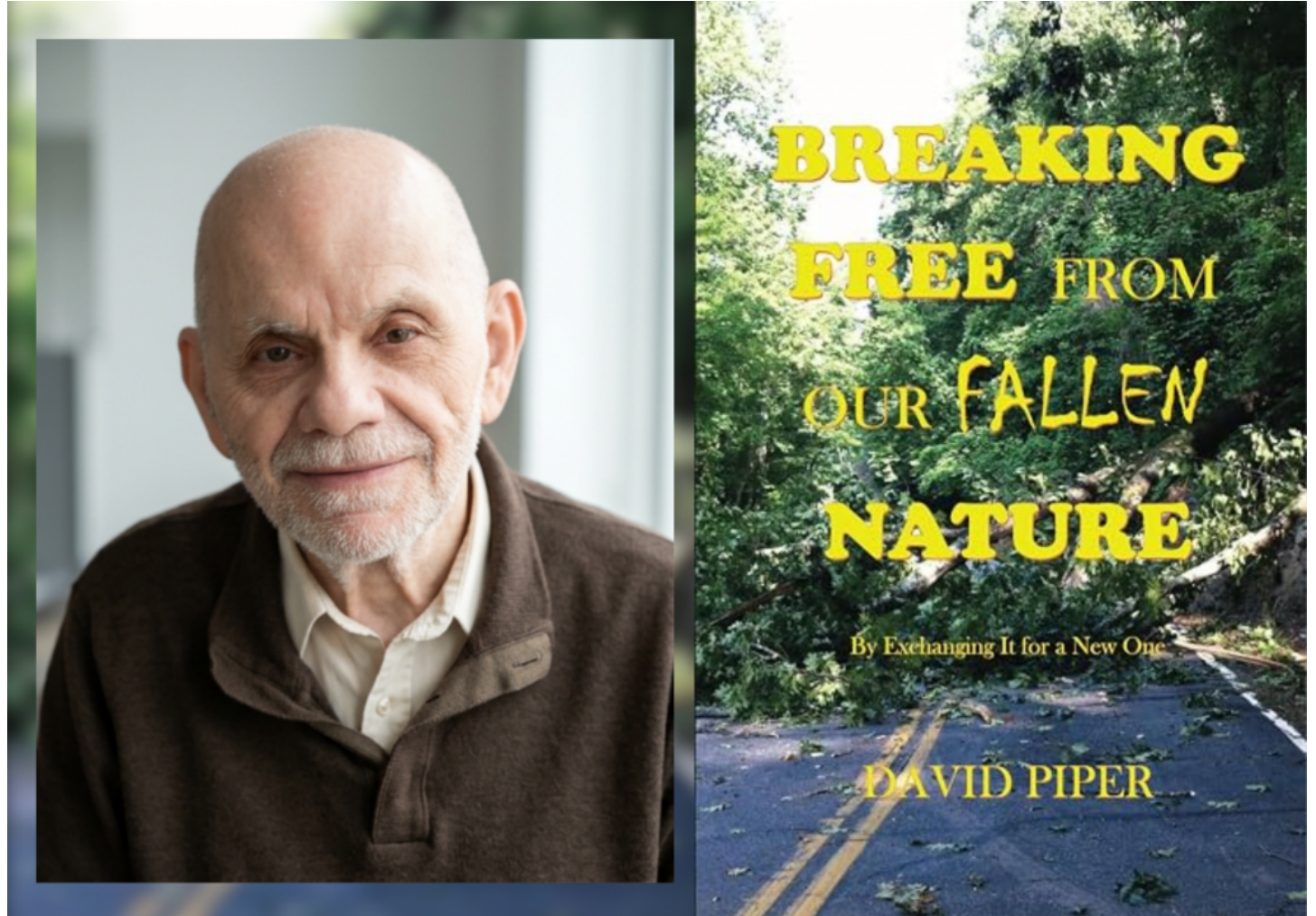


David Piper Uncovers the Roots of Inner Change Through Faith and Renewal

Through simple hand-drawn storytelling, the newly released video examines the deeper causes of recurring struggles and the Christian path toward becoming new.

Using hand-drawn visuals and a straightforward narrative, the video explores the difference between changing outward behavior and addressing the deeper condition of the heart. It offers viewers an accessible introduction to Piper's message of spiritual renewal, inner transformation, and freedom from patterns that continue to return.

At the center of the video is the image of a tree whose visible damage reflects problems developing beneath the surface. Through this metaphor, Piper examines struggles such as anger, worry, discouragement, pride, and broken relationships. The illustrated format presents these themes in a clear and relatable way, showing how temporary solutions may repair appearances without addressing the

underlying causes. Rather than suggesting that personal growth means becoming a more improved version of the old self, the video points to the Christian belief that genuine renewal begins with becoming new through a transformed inner life.

"But sometimes the storm isn't the real problem. The problem is what's been growing underneath. The roots were already damaged. The storm simply revealed it," a line from the video.

Piper's message is grounded in decades of quiet service, ministry, and teaching. From 1978 to 1991, he served as a pastor across four provinces in Western Canada, later dedicating years to his church's children's ministry and to leading a weekly Bible study for seniors in Hamilton, Ontario. For 25 years, he has also served as a night prayer partner with the Crossroads prayer lines. Alongside his wife of 48 years, Piper has built a life centered on faith, family, and service, with a married son and three grandchildren.

The illustrated piece is intended for viewers drawn to Christian faith, personal reflection, spiritual growth, and the search for freedom from recurring struggles. Through this simple and accessible presentation, Piper hopes to share his message of renewal with a wider audience, including Christian communities and readers across Asia who may find meaning in its reflections on faith, inner change, and becoming new.
