

ExhVerse Helps Teachers Bring Class Artwork Into an Online Art Gallery

An online art gallery created with ExhVerse brings class artwork and student descriptions into a virtual space families can visit through a shared link.

By presenting artwork alongside titles and short descriptions, the platform gives educators a way to organize a [student art showcase](#) that introduces both individual contributions and the project connecting them.

Teachers begin by choosing a pre-designed 3D gallery environment and uploading prepared images of the work. Drawings, paintings, photographs, and images of sculptures can be presented with accompanying information. An exhibition introduction can explain the assignment, while individual descriptions give students space to share what they wanted to communicate.

A class working from the same brief can produce very different results. In an assignment about an everyday object, one student might concentrate on shadows, another on color, and another on the patterns surrounding it. Bringing these interpretations into one online art gallery allows visitors to explore how classmates responded to a common starting point.

"Families should be able to see the whole class's work and understand the project behind it," said Winston Zhang, CEO of ExhVerse. "With ExhVerse, teachers can use an online art gallery to turn a student art showcase into something families can explore together."

Visitors can enter the exhibition on a computer, tablet, or smartphone without installing a separate app. They can move through the gallery, examine images, and open artwork descriptions at their own pace. Teachers can share the visitor link through a school newsletter or class portal, giving families a direct route to the exhibition.

The format can support projects of different sizes. An art club might organize a focused display around one medium, while a department could prepare separate exhibitions for different classes. A school arts festival could include a digital collection alongside its activities, allowing families to browse student contributions before or after their visit.

For students, preparing work for an online art gallery adds an audience to the assignment. Choosing a title and writing a short explanation asks them to consider what someone outside the classroom needs to know. A description might identify an unusual material, explain a visual reference, or draw attention to a detail that could otherwise be missed.

Teachers planning their first exhibition can consult FlipHTML5's guide to organizing a student art showcase. It includes an adaptable submission brief, an example gallery layout, and a family invitation, helping educators move from collecting artwork to presenting a coherent class exhibition. ExhVerse provides the 3D environment in which they can put that plan into practice.

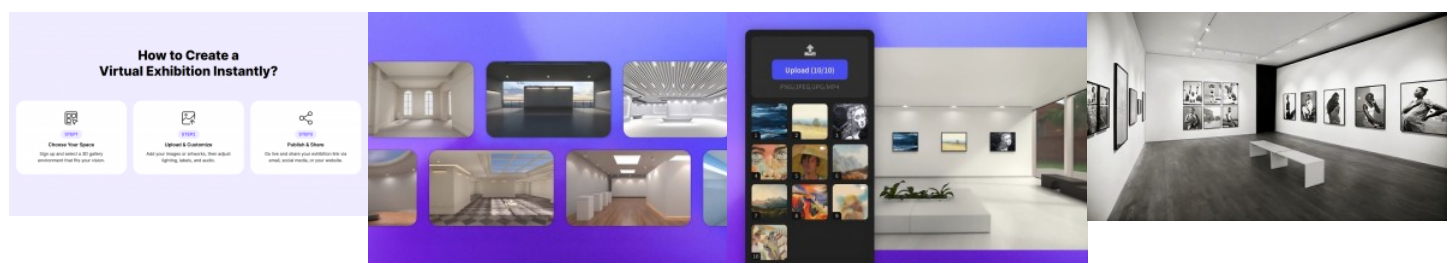
ExhVerse also offers a [free version](#), currently supporting up to three exhibitions with 30 works per exhibition. This gives teachers a starting point for a class collection or an art club project, with capacity to be considered when deciding how many pieces each student contributes.

An [online art gallery](#) can give families a fuller view of what a class has made. Individual pieces retain their own titles and explanations, while the exhibition brings them together under a shared project. For schools, that creates an opportunity to present classroom learning through the work and words of the students themselves.
