This is part of a wider change in home care across the UK. Families caring for older relatives or people recovering from illness are asking if full-time help at home could be a better choice than residential care. For many, it can be and Greenwood Homecare has spent years building local teams and training carers

Why Families Are Turning to 24 Hour Care at Home

There is often a specific moment that prompts the conversation. A parent has fallen more than once in a few weeks. Someone wakes disoriented in the night. A hospital discharge comes with instructions that nobody should really be managing alone. When needs like these start to stack up, a few short visits a week stop being enough and 24 hour care at home becomes a serious option worth exploring.

Unlike a brief morning or evening visit, 24 hour home care means a carer or a small consistent team of carers, is present throughout the day and night. This is sometimes referred to as live in care, since it typically involves a trained carer living in the home or as 24/7 home care, reflecting that support is available whenever it is needed rather than at fixed times.

Greenwood Homecare has been arranging this type of support for families across Cambridgeshire and Lincolnshire, working with people living with dementia, Parkinson's and other progressive conditions, as well as those recovering after a hospital stay or simply wanting the reassurance of continuous home care once falls or nighttime confusion have become a pattern.

How the Service Is Delivered

A typical arrangement starts with one dedicated carer moving into a spare room and gradually learning a person's routines, right down to how they take their tea or what time they like to get up. Because caring around the clock is demanding work, most live in carers work on a rota, commonly two weeks on and two weeks off with both carers introduced to the family in advance so handovers stay smooth. Carers also take a short break each day which can be covered by a pop in carer where continuous in house support is preferred.

For people with more complex needs, care plans can involve two carers splitting day and night or a live in carer supported by overnight visiting care. A typical package may include personal care, medication support, mobility assistance, meal preparation, light household tasks, companionship and overnight help, tailored to the individual rather than delivered as a fixed template.

A Person Centred Alternative to Residential Care

For many families, particularly those supporting someone with dementia, staying somewhere familiar with a consistent, known carer nearby brings real reassurance that a change of environment cannot easily replace. Round the clock home care also allows couples to remain together with one carer often able to support both partners rather than the household paying for two separate care home places.

Elderly care at home, dementia care at home and respite care for family carers who need a proper break are among the most common reasons families get in touch. Cost naturally varies depending on the level of support required and whether one or two carers are involved and Greenwood Homecare provides a clear quote with nothing hidden following a free home assessment.
