Shippingwell (SPW) provides standardized Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) logistics, overseas fulfillment and multimodal transport services to support cross-border commerce across North America, Europe, Southeast Asia, the Middle East, South America&Africa.

Established in 2021, Guangdong Shippingwell Supply Chain Limited (operating globally under the brand

name SPW Supply Chain) is headquartered in Dongguan, Guangdong Province—a principal industrial manufacturing hub in South China. To support its international operations, SPW maintains localized overseas branches and strategic operational nodes in Rochester, New York, as well as in Hong Kong, the United Kingdom, Germany, France, and Australia.

SPW Supply Chain Executive Headquarters

SPW operates with a total global facility footprint exceeding 100,000 square meters of warehouse space, supported by an operational staff of 50 supply chain professionals. The enterprise maintains core regulatory qualifications within international logistics, including a Non-Vessel Operating Common Carrier license (NOVCC GD202104273385) and an official Record Filing Form for International Freight Forwarders (Registration No. 10043003).

The company's internal operations team averages over 20 years of collective industry experience in international freight forwarding, customs clearance protocols, and warehousing management. SPW maintains long-term service contracts with more than 20 global ocean shipping lines, air cargo carriers, and regional last-mile delivery providers. Through a proprietary digital logistics platform, the company processes over 10,000 standard TEU containers annually, offering real-time cargo monitoring, automated order management, and multi-stage compliance auditing for a customer portfolio of more than 20,000 corporate clients globally.

Products & Services

SPW structures its core service portfolio into three integrated divisions: country-specific DDP door-to-door transportation, overseas warehouse fulfillment, and global ocean/rail/road multimodal carrier solutions.

China to USA DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

China to USA DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

SPW provides a end-to-end Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) transport framework servicing all 50 U.S. states. The service integrates origin pickup at Chinese manufacturing facilities, export customs processing, international trunk line shipping, U.S. customs entry, tariff assessment and settlement, and final-mile commercial or residential delivery. SPW collaborates with licensed U.S. customs brokers to navigate U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) inspections and tax compliance. Transportation configurations include expedited ocean lines (20–30 days door-to-door), economy ocean transit (35–45 days), and direct air freight (5–9 days). The service accommodates general commercial goods, Amazon FBA warehouse replenishment, and both Full Container Load (FCL) and Less than Container Load (LCL) shipments.

China to Canada DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

Designed for complete coverage across Canadian provinces, this service addresses import compliance, Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) clearances, and Goods and Services Tax (GST/HST) settlements. Transit timelines range from 25–35 days for expedited sea freight, 38–48 days for standard sea freight, and 5–9 days for air freight. Value-added capabilities include pre-shipment cargo integrity checks, Amazon Canada prep and labeling, container devanning, and localized freight delivery to retail distribution hubs or private addresses.

China to UK DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

The UK DDP shipping line provides comprehensive delivery coverage across the United Kingdom. Utilizing licensed UK customs agents, the service manages EORI declarations, HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC) duty and VAT clearance, and regulatory compliance. Modal options encompass expedited ocean (30–40 days), economy ocean (40–50 days), and air freight (5–10 days). It handles e-commerce inventory, commercial bulk cargo, and consolidated LCL shipments with real-time tracking from warehouse origin to final delivery.

China to Southeast Asia DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

SPW covers key trade corridors across Southeast Asia, including Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, the Philippines, Cambodia, Laos, and Myanmar. Transportation routes leverage land trucking, fast ocean shipping (7–18 days), standard ocean shipping (20–30 days), and express air freight (2–6 days). Local certified customs agents oversee import permit applications, regional tax filings, and final delivery to urban e-commerce warehouses or remote commercial locations.

China to Middle East DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

Serving commercial markets in Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Kuwait, Bahrain, Oman, Israel, and Egypt, this service resolves regional customs clearance hurdles and duty processing. Transit timelines span 22–32 days for expedited ocean, 35–45 days for economy ocean, and 4–8 days for air cargo. Services incorporate packaging reinforcement, pre-loading quality checks, and targeted solutions for complex regional import regulations.

China to South America DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

Addressing supply chain requirements in Brazil, Chile, Peru, Colombia, Argentina, and Ecuador, SPW delivers an end-to-end DDP framework handling South American customs documentation, duty payment, and long-distance inland transit. Transit schedules average 30–40 days for expedited sea, 42–55 days for economy sea, and 6–10 days for air freight, supporting both bulk industrial machinery and consumer goods.

China to Africa DDP Door-to-Door Shipping

SPW operates DDP shipping lanes connecting Chinese ports to major economic centers in West, East, Southern, and North Africa, including Nigeria, Kenya, South Africa, Ghana, Tanzania, and Morocco. Ocean transit times vary between 32 and 58 days, while air freight delivers within 5–9 days. Local agents manage document verification, physical customs inspections, and regional inland carriage.

China to Europe Railway Shipping

Providing an intermediate transport option between sea and air freight, SPW runs overland rail services connecting China to Germany, France, Italy, Poland, Spain, and neighboring European countries. Featuring fixed dispatch schedules and a door-to-door transit timeframe of 18–25 days, rail transport offers predictable delivery cycles and competitive unit costs for heavy commercial cargo and e-commerce inventory.

China to Europe Road Trucking Delivery

SPW offers cross-border transcontinental road freight servicing the European Union. Operating both Less-than-Truckload (LTL) and Full-Truckload (FTL) routes, international trucking delivers a door-to-door transit time of 7–15 days. The service is structured for time-sensitive commercial inventory requiring rapid dispatch and flexible delivery routing.

Global FCL Full Container Load Freight Service

Global Full Container Load Shipping Operations

For high-volume manufacturers, trading enterprises, and industrial brand owners, SPW manages direct Full Container Load (FCL) ocean freight utilizing standard 20GP, 40GP, and 40HQ container equipment. The service covers major maritime routes between China and North America, Europe, Southeast Asia, the Middle East, Africa, Australia, and South America. By securing dedicated container capacity directly with vessel operators, SPW minimizes cargo re-handling, eliminates cross-contamination risks, and maintains consistent port-to-port and door-to-door schedules.

China Global LCL Consolidation Freight Service

SPW's Less-than-Container Load (LCL) service consolidates smaller cargo volumes (starting from 0.5 CBM or 1 pallet) into shared containers at dedicated regional consolidation hubs. The service includes cargo sorting, protective pallet wrapping, customs filing, ocean/air/rail trunk line transport, destination deconsolidation, and final door delivery across all major global destination markets.

Overseas Warehouse & Dropshipping Service

SPW operates specialized overseas warehouse infrastructure located in five core international markets: the United States, Canada, the United Kingdom, Spain, and Germany. These facilities provide localized inventory storage, multi-channel order fulfillment (supporting Amazon, Walmart, eBay, Shopify, and independent e-commerce storefronts), order picking and packing, custom product labeling, and localized return processing. Facilities operate with same-day or next-day order processing capabilities, enabling 1-to-3-day local ground delivery to end customers.

Market & Clients

SPW operates as a 100% export-oriented logistics provider, serving a client portfolio that spans commercial trading entities, original equipment manufacturers (OEMs), brand owners, and cross-border e-commerce sellers across North America, South America, Europe, Southeast Asia, the Middle East, and Africa.

SPW Logistics Regulatory Certification

To ensure operational compliance across varying trade jurisdictions, SPW integrates quality inspection and risk management protocols directly into its supply chain workflows. Pre-loading inspections, packaging durability audits, in-transit GPS tracking, destination customs compliance reviews, and delivery sign-off confirmations are applied across all shipping modes.

In one representative operational deployment, SPW manages full-chain DDP ocean freight services for Neil, a Canadian trading company. SPW coordinates origin pickup, export customs declarations, ocean transport, Canadian import customs clearance, GST/duty payments, and final door delivery for over 100 FCL container shipments annually. The operational framework maintains stable transit schedules, verified compliance with Canadian import regulations, transparent fee structures, and end-to-end shipment visibility.

To accommodate international financial workflows, SPW supports multiple secure cross-border payment structures, including Telegraphic Transfer (T/T), PayPal, full payments, and milestone-based installment options governed by formal legal contracts.

Vision

As global trade dynamics continue to evolve under shifting regulatory frameworks, rising compliance mandates, and changing e-commerce fulfillment expectations, SPW is focusing its strategic development on deepening its physical infrastructure and digital logistics capabilities.

The enterprise plans to expand its network of localized overseas warehouses, further integrate proprietary cargo-tracking systems with carrier databases, and strengthen direct carrier alliances across emerging trade routes in Latin America, Africa, and the Middle East. By standardizing cross-border logistics workflows and reducing operational friction in customs clearance, SPW aims to increase supply chain predictability for global commercial enterprises.
