Its lightweight adhesive for food flexible packaging is designed for different lightweight food and fast-moving consumer goods applications, including snacks, baked goods and confectionery. The solution supports dry, flexographic and solvent-free lamination processes, allowing manufacturers to select a suitable bonding approach according to their production equipment and packaging structures. The product is positioned around bonding reliability, operational convenience and production cost optimization.

According to the company, the product complies with relevant safety standards for food-contact adhesives and is designed without migration of toxic and harmful substances, odor or discoloration. It supports both dry and solvent-free lamination processes.

These characteristics demonstrate how ASTER approaches food-grade adhesive development from an application perspective. Instead of focusing solely on bonding strength, the company considers the broader requirements of food packaging production, including sealing performance, appearance quality, processing convenience and safety.

The company's yogurt and milk powder can lid film adhesive follows a similar application-specific approach. It is designed for can lid film production involving deep drawing and high-temperature sterilization and is intended for aluminum-plastic multilayer structures. ASTER states that the product meets relevant food-contact adhesive safety requirements and is designed to avoid migration of toxic and harmful substances, odor and discoloration.

Performance for Demanding Packaging Applications

Performance requirements can vary significantly depending on the packaging structure and

manufacturing process. Lightweight snack packaging may prioritize process flexibility and production efficiency, while retortable food packaging requires stronger resistance to elevated temperatures and demanding processing conditions.

ASTER addresses these differences with specialized adhesive formulations. Its high-temperature-resistant adhesive for food flexible packaging is designed for aluminum-plastic structures and offers retort performance at 135°C for 40 minutes. The product also features high initial tack, high peel strength and a soft adhesive layer intended to support the appearance of laminated products.

Such application-specific development can be particularly relevant for manufacturers seeking to optimize production without replacing established equipment. By offering adhesive solutions compatible with different lamination processes and packaging structures, ASTER can support manufacturers in selecting products according to their technical requirements rather than relying on a one-size-fits-all adhesive.

The broader ASTER product portfolio also covers adhesives for pharmaceutical flexible packaging, metal packaging film lamination, household appliance panels, photovoltaic backsheets and soft-pack lithium battery films. This range demonstrates the company's experience across multiple multilayer composite applications and polymer-based bonding technologies.

Manufacturing Infrastructure and Quality Management

Behind product performance is the ability to maintain consistent manufacturing and quality control. ASTER also maintains research and testing capabilities supported by equipment including mass spectrometers, liquid chromatographs, gas chromatographs, infrared spectrometers, electron microscopes, viscometers, micro-moisture analyzers, universal testing machines and heat sealers. These capabilities provide technical support for product development, quality evaluation and application testing.

The company further reports that its R&D team includes doctors and post-doctors, alongside experienced production, quality-control and global sales teams. This combination allows ASTER to connect formulation development with manufacturing requirements and customer application needs.

The development of food packaging adhesives is increasingly moving toward a balance between safety, technical performance and manufacturing economics.
