When the company's fabric is used, the MOQ is 300 pieces per style per color. Selected styles can also incorporate custom design, color, and branding requirements.

A second stretch family uses 72% polyester, 21% rayon, and 7% spandex at 175–205gsm. It provides 4-way stretch, wrinkle resistance, antimicrobial properties, and anti-static performance. When E-SONG APPAREL fabric is used, the MOQ is 300 pieces per style per color. Buyers can request a USD 100-per-set development sample, which can be credited against the bulk order.

Printed 140gsm polyester-spandex, recycled-polyester/spandex nurse styles, and other stretch constructions broaden the fabric landscape further, giving procurement teams choices in weight, fiber blend, hand feel, and intended silhouette. This variety allows buyers to align the exact material properties with the expected wear environment.

Each material should remain attached to its own SKU specification so a buyer does not transfer finish, weight, MOQ, or sample terms from one stretch product to another. How Do Necklines and Top Shapes Change Fit and Merchandising?

V-neck tops create a familiar scrub-set core, while Mandarin collars and stand-collar or tunic formats give the assortment more structured or fashion-oriented upper-body options. This variety in neckline construction allows distributors to segment their offerings for different clinical environments, ranging from general hospital wards to specialized aesthetic or dental clinics.

Printed Mandarin-collar products add another merchandising layer by combining pattern, collar construction, and flare-leg styling, whereas solid-color V-neck sets can function as highly repeatable

core procurement programs.

The top design decision should be made together with the fabric selection and pant format because the neckline alone does not define the final fit story. A complete set architecture ensures that the upper and lower garments coordinate effectively for the intended professional role.

How Do Jogger, Cargo and Flare Pants Change the Range?

Jogger pants create a tapered athletic profile that pairs naturally with several V-neck stretch sets, meeting the demand for modern, active-inspired medical apparel. Cargo and wide-cargo pants introduce a different leg shape and storage-oriented construction for buyers who want a utility-led scrub category designed for high-capacity pocket needs.

Flare-leg pants pair with selected Mandarin-collar and nurse-uniform designs, giving the range a silhouette that is visually distinct from joggers and cargo pants. This styling caters to fashion-oriented healthcare segments while maintaining the required 4-way stretch performance.

Tapered nurse scrub pants add another narrower-leg option, allowing distributors to separate pant categories by silhouette and pocket architecture instead of color alone. This separation provides a more sophisticated merchandising approach for private-label collections.

[E-SONG APPAREL](#) can use these format differences as starting points for custom medical-uniform development rather than forcing one pant pattern across every collection. By keeping these silhouettes independent, the manufacturer supports highly customized uniform sourcing.

What Should Private-Label Buyers Put in a Stretch-Scrub RFQ?

A stretch-scrub RFQ should define the whole set so the production team receives one unambiguous top, pant, fabric, color, and branding combination. Clear documentation accelerates the quoting process and prevents miscommunication during the sampling phase.

A private-label stretch-scrub RFQ should capture these fields together. The supplier can quote and sample one exact top-and-pant configuration without transferring fabric, fit, or pocket details between unrelated scrub styles.

- Exact top neckline, collar, pocket, and length details.
- Pant silhouette, waistband, pocket layout, rise, and leg opening.
- Fabric composition, weight, stretch direction, finish, and color.
- Size run and measurement specifications.
- Logo, labels, trims, contrast details, and packaging.
- Quantity by SKU and color, plus sample requirements. When E-SONG APPAREL fabric is used, plan for 300 pieces per style per color. The development-sample fee is USD 100 per set and can be credited against the bulk order.
- Target production schedule and repeat-order expectations.
