San Ramon, California Sep 17, 2026 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - Dental offices across the Bay Area are adopting AI tools faster than most teams can evaluate them — for scheduling, patient messaging, imaging review, and clinical note-taking. Few practices, however, have a structured way to separate the tools that genuinely save time from the ones that quietly introduce data-privacy or clinical-accuracy risk.

Dr. Ron Hassanzadeh, founder of [iSmile Orthodontics in San Ramon](#), is addressing that gap directly. On **September 24, 2026**, his practice will host the "[September Soirée](#)," a free continuing education (CE) seminar at **Bridges Golf Club, 9000 S Gale Ridge Rd, San Ramon, CA 94582**, built specifically for dental office teams — including front-desk staff, hygienists, and administrators, not doctors alone.

Why this matters for local dental practices: Most CE programming on AI is written for clinicians. This session is designed around the reality that AI tools now touch nearly every role inside a dental office, from the person answering phones to the doctor reviewing a scan — so the whole team needs a shared, practical understanding of where the technology helps and where it can go wrong.

What the Seminar Covers

The presentation walks attendees through three practical areas rather than promoting any single product:

- **Where AI is already working** — appointment scheduling, automated reminders, imaging triage, and drafting treatment notes, freeing staff time for direct patient interaction.
- **Where AI introduces risk** — unmanaged patient-data exposure, and the danger of treating AI-generated outputs as final answers without a human review step.
- **What a practice can put in place immediately** — baseline safeguards a dental office can adopt regardless of which AI vendor or platform it uses.

"AI is already inside a lot of dental offices, whether the team has formally decided to use it or not," said Dr. Ron Hassanzadeh, founder of iSmile Orthodontics. "This session isn't a pitch for any one product. It's meant to give everyone on the team — including the people at the front desk — a clear, realistic picture of what to use, what to be cautious about, and how to keep the practice protected while doing it."

Why This Is Relevant Beyond San Ramon

The concerns raised in the session — patient-data privacy, over-reliance on unverified AI outputs, and inconsistent staff training — mirror a broader shift happening across U.S. dental practices as AI adoption accelerates faster than formal guidance from professional bodies. Local practices considering similar internal training may find the seminar's format (free, CE-accredited, open to full teams) a useful model.

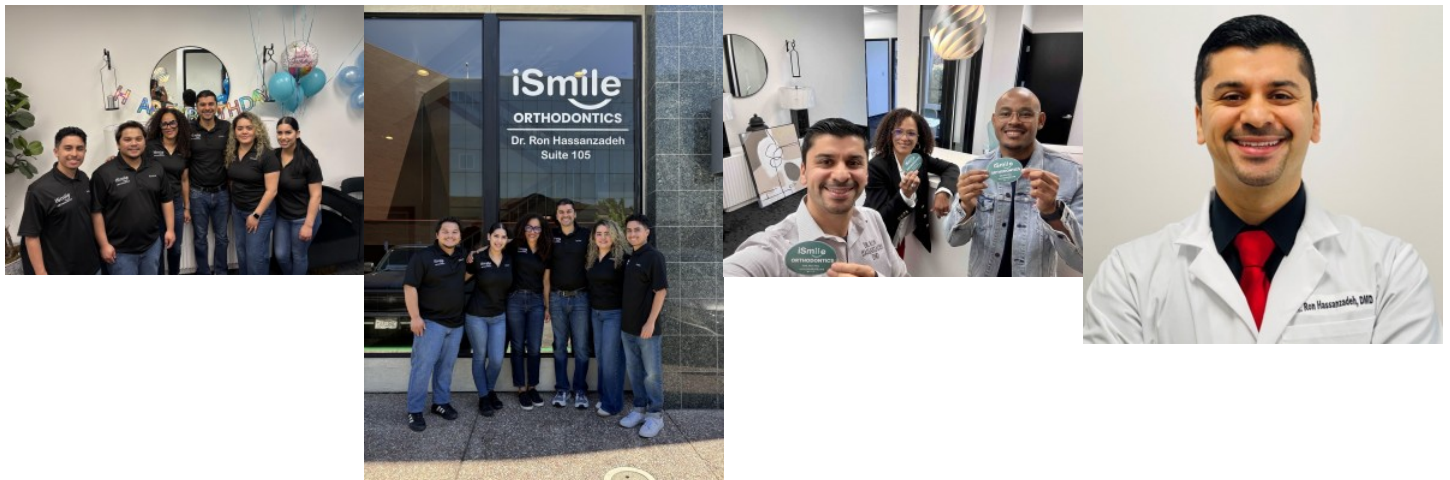
