Early experience in crisis care. Before relocating to the United States, [Jean Paul Karangwa](#) exposure to nursing came through work with the Red Cross in refugee camps, where he supported people affected by conflict.

Entry into U.S. healthcare. After arriving in the U.S. in 1999, he began in housekeeping roles before moving into a nursing home as a Nurse's Aide, marking his first formal step into direct patient care.

Nursing education and advancement. He pursued further training to become a Licensed Practical Nurse, and later completed the additional education required to become a Registered Nurse.

Entrepreneurial groundwork. Prior to founding Caring Bees, Karangwa acquired a convenience store, grew its value, and sold it for several times his initial investment, building business experience alongside his clinical background.

Founding Caring Bees Healthcare. In 2012, he founded Caring Bees Healthcare Inc., combining his nursing background with business development skills to build a home healthcare agency centered on personalized, in-home patient care.

What does Caring Bees Healthcare provide?
