

KWT Spider Launches Version 3.0, Extending Its SEO Crawler From Windows to macOS and Linux

KWT Spider version 3.0 ends the software's Windows only availability, adding native macOS and Linux installers alongside a rebuilt crawl engine.

New Delhi, Delhi Sep 3, 2026 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - **KWT Spider**, a developer of a desktop based technical SEO crawling application, released **version 3.0** of its software on September 3, 2026. The release marks the first time the application has been available on operating systems other than **Windows**, adding native installers for **macOS**, supporting Apple Silicon and Intel processors, and for **Linux**, distributed as AppImage, deb, and rpm packages. According to the company, the same interface, crawl modes, and reporting structure are now available regardless of which of the three operating systems a user installs it on.

Version 3.0 also replaces the method the software uses to process large websites, writing crawl data to a local database file instead of storing it in active memory, a change the company states allows crawls exceeding 50,000 URLs to run without the slowdown associated with earlier versions.

"The software was built for Windows first because that is where the earliest customer base was, but limiting the tool to one operating system was limiting who could use it," said a spokesperson for the company. "Version 3.0 removes that limitation without changing how the application functions."

The release also adds a feature that scores individual pages on how they may be read by artificial intelligence based search systems, along with a mode for reviewing local files before publication and the ability to resume an interrupted crawl. Existing reporting categories and crawl modes from earlier versions remain in place.

[KWT Spider](#) is distributed in a free version limited to 250 URLs per session and a licensed version, tested past 50,000 URLs, that adds data export and the complete page scoring feature. Installers for Windows, macOS, and Linux are available from the company's website.

KWT Spider is a company that develops desktop software for auditing the technical structure of websites, designed to run on a user's own device rather than through a cloud hosted service. It is used by marketing agencies, internal marketing departments, and software developers to review website structure before and after publication.
