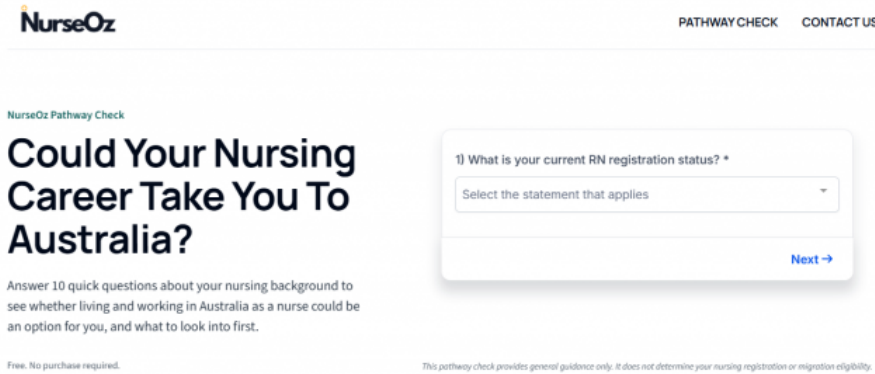
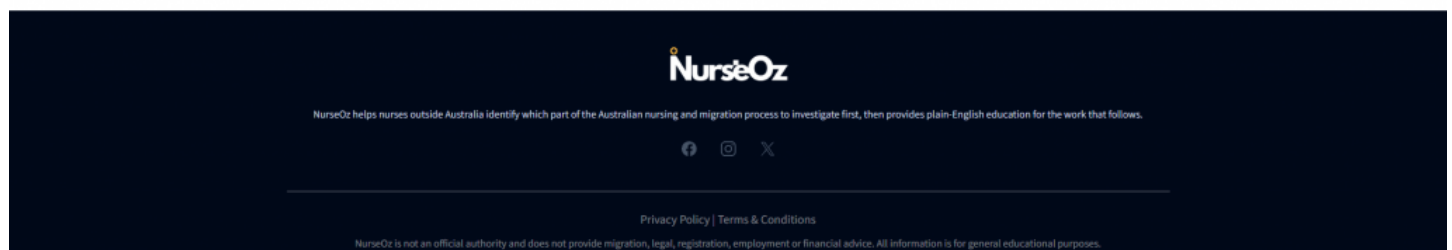


NurseOz.com Introduces a Free Pathway Check for Nurses Considering Australia

The online survey gives internationally qualified nurses a clearer starting point for researching registration, skills assessment and migration.

The free online survey asks nurses about relevant parts of their professional background and directs them to general educational information based on their responses. It is designed to reduce the early confusion that can arise when nurses encounter several separate systems at once, including nursing registration, migration skills assessment, visa planning and employment.

These systems are connected, but they do not make the same decision. Nursing registration is handled through the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia, administered by Ahpra. ANMAC conducts skills assessments for skilled migration. Visa decisions sit with the Australian Department of Home Affairs, while employers and recruiters make their own hiring and sponsorship decisions.

“Many nurses begin with a simple question about moving to Australia and quickly find themselves comparing information from several different authorities,” said Andy Michaels, Founder at NurseOz. “The Pathway Check is designed to help them organise that first stage of research and understand what may be worth investigating next.”

The survey is intended for currently registered general or adult nurses outside Australia. Its results are educational and deliberately conservative. A result does not confirm eligibility, rule out other routes or replace an assessment by the relevant authority. Individual pathways can differ, and users are

encouraged to check current official requirements and seek qualified advice when needed.

The Pathway Check reflects the wider purpose of NurseOz: making complex Australian nursing and migration information easier to understand without blurring the line between education and personal advice.
