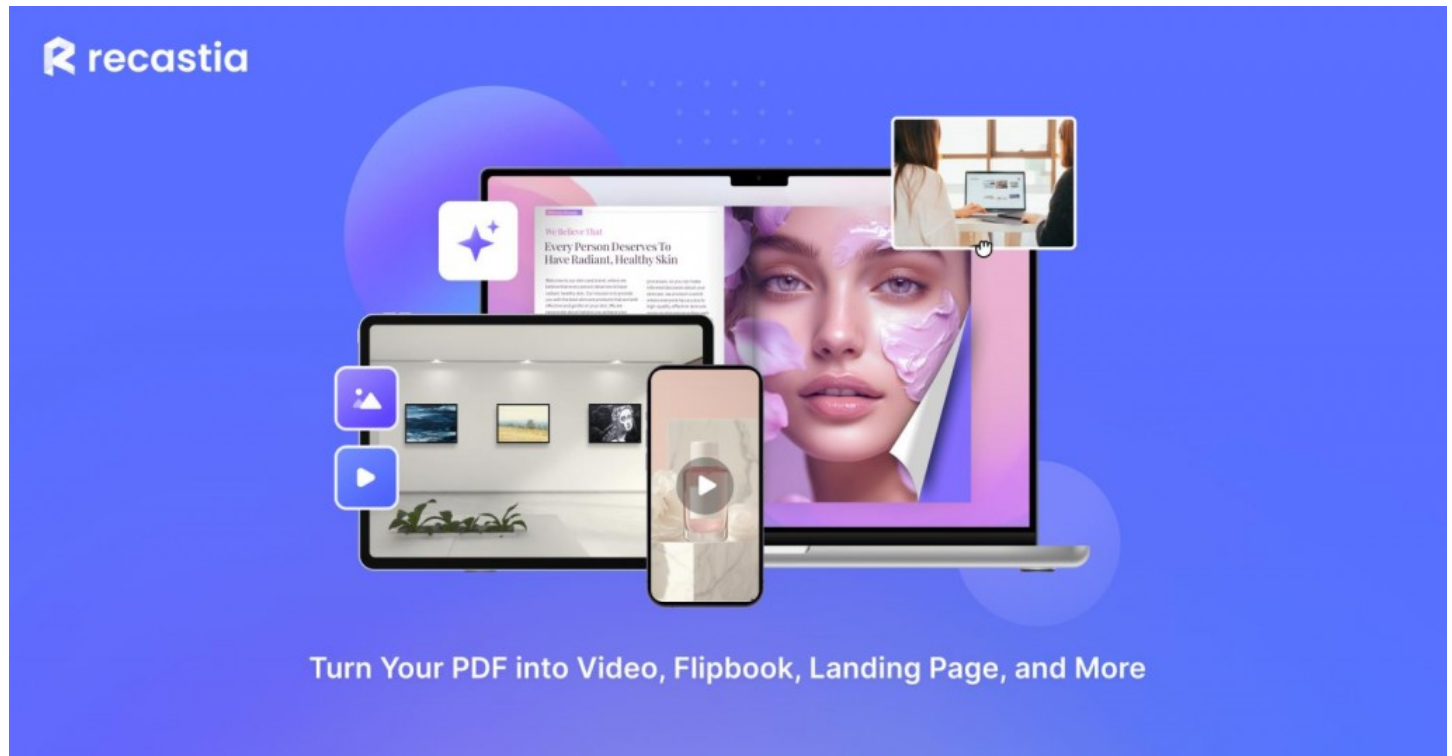


Recastia Turns a PDF to Website Through an Automated Design Pipeline

Recastia turns a PDF to website in the browser, analyzing the file, extracting an outline, and designing a responsive page teams can fine-tune by clicking elements on the page.

Sep 28, 2026 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - A finished PDF often holds everything a campaign needs — the message, the schedule, the visuals — yet turning it into a live web page still tends to mean briefing a developer and waiting for a build. Recastia removes that step by letting a team generate a [PDF to website](#) straight from the document, so the file becomes a working landing page instead of a request sitting in a queue.

The process runs inside Recastia's PDF to Landing Page workspace. A user uploads the PDF, and the AI moves through a clear build sequence: it analyzes the document, extracts an outline, designs the page, and develops it, finishing a first version in roughly ten minutes. Because each PDF to website is generated from the source file itself, the structure and key points of the original carry into the layout automatically, and the task keeps running even if the window is closed.

What comes back is a responsive one-page site rather than a flat export. A generated PDF to website includes a navigation bar, a hero section with a headline and subheading, call-to-action buttons, and content blocks pulled from the document, all styled with colors drawn from the source so the page reflects the original branding. The result reads like a purpose-built page instead of a converted file.

From there, the page stays editable. Clicking any element on a PDF to website opens controls for its text, color, and background, while a desktop-and-mobile preview confirms how the layout adapts across screens before anything goes live. Once saved, the page is hosted at a shareable link and paired with a QR code, so a campaign can move from document to published URL in a single sitting.

The website is not the only way to reuse that upload. The same source file that becomes a PDF to website can also be turned into a [PDF to video](#) for audiences who prefer a short clip, giving teams a second format from the document they already prepared.

"A document already contains the hard part, which is the thinking. The job left is turning it into something people can visit," said Winston Zhang, CEO of Recastia. "Generating a PDF to website from that file gives teams a live page they can edit and publish themselves, without a separate development cycle."
