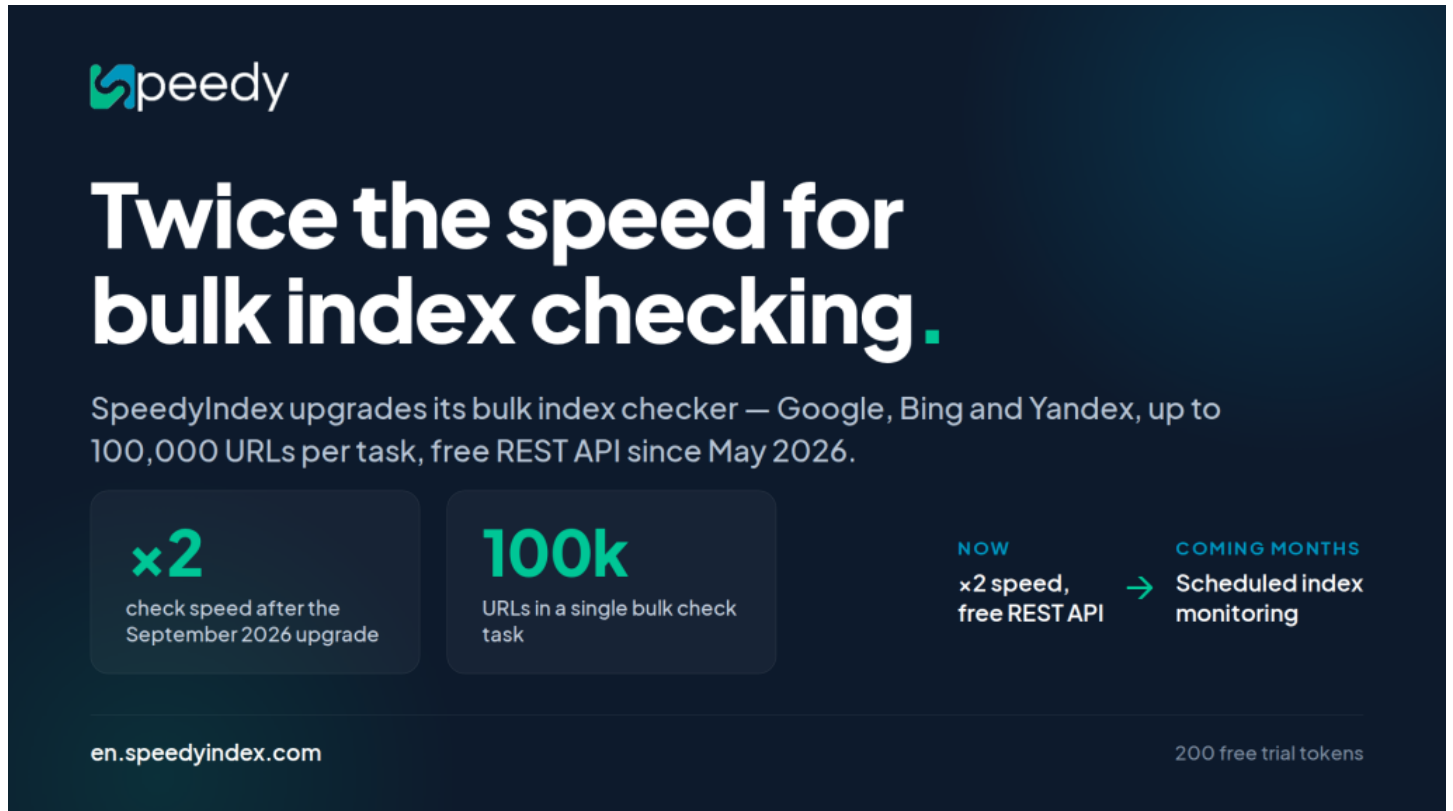


SpeedyIndex Doubles the Speed of Its Bulk Index Checker for Google, Bing and Yandex

After a September 2026 upgrade, the SpeedyIndex bulk index checker runs twice as fast (internal data). Launched with a free REST API in May 2026, it takes up to 100,000 URLs per task — backlinks included, no Search Console verification.

Helsinki, Uusimaa Sep 14, 2026 ([IssueWire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - [SpeedyIndex](https://www.speedyindex.com), a link indexing service for SEO teams and agencies, announced a speed upgrade for its bulk index checker: according to internal data from September 2026, checks now complete twice as fast. The checker verifies whether URLs are present in Google, Bing and Yandex, accepts up to 100,000 URLs in a single task and does not require site verification in Google Search Console or Yandex Webmaster. The REST API for bulk checks, released in May 2026, remains free and included in all accounts.

The upgrade is the first major update to the checker since its global launch in May 2026 and applies to all interfaces of the tool at once.

SpeedyIndex Free REST API: Four Months After Launch

The [Google index checker](#) answers one question at scale: is a given URL present in a search engine's index or not. A user pastes a list of links or sends it through the API and receives a report that separates indexed pages from pages the search engine has not included. The tool accepts any public URL, which makes it applicable to client websites, competitor pages and external backlinks — categories that Google Search Console does not cover, since it reports only on verified properties, checks about 2,000 URLs per property and returns data with a delay of 3 to 4 days (figures from the company's May 2026

announcement).

API access has been free since the May 2026 launch and is included in all accounts, without monthly fees or daily limits; checks are billed pay-as-you-go at \$0.0007 per URL (pricing announced in May 2026), and purchased tokens do not expire. The API works with Python, PHP and Node.js integrations, so the same checks can run inside an agency's own scripts and dashboards. Typical integrations include:

- **Backlink verification** — confirming that links from outreach and link building campaigns sit on indexed pages, since a backlink on an unindexed page passes no value.
- **Content monitoring** — checking whether newly published pages have entered the index, without opening Search Console for each property.
- **Client reporting** — exporting indexed and non-indexed counts into agency deliverables on a schedule the agency controls.
- **Technical audits** — combining index checks with the service's free utilities, which detect redirects, noindex directives, 404 responses and 5xx errors, and extract URLs from sitemaps.

"The May launch confirmed that agencies want index checks inside their own scripts rather than in one more dashboard. The September upgrade answers how they use the tool in practice: lists keep growing, and a task of up to 100,000 URLs now completes in half the time," said Linda Bjorkvin, Project Manager at SpeedyIndex.

SpeedyIndex Checks Google, Bing and Yandex in One Tool

Many standalone checkers report on Google alone. The SpeedyIndex checker covers Google, Bing and Yandex in one interface, which matters for teams whose clients receive traffic from more than one search engine. A single uploaded list returns per-engine results, so a page indexed in Google but missing from Bing or Yandex becomes visible in one pass rather than three.

The checker is available in the web dashboard, in the Telegram bot, in the Chrome extension and through the API, and the results match across all four interfaces.

SpeedyIndex Doubles Check Speed and Connects Checking to Indexing

According to internal data from September 2026, the infrastructure upgrade halved the time the checker needs to process a list. The report returns live SERP status and, for indexed pages, the current title tag. For SpeedyIndex the check is also the first step of a larger workflow: URLs that turn out to be missing from the index can be submitted for indexing in the same account.

Before submission the service runs a free availability pre-check that filters out pages with HTTP 404, 410 and 451 responses, robots.txt and noindex restrictions, media files and URLs that are already indexed, so tokens are not spent on links that cannot or need not be processed. Submitted links are then re-checked automatically: on day 7 for Google and on day 15 for Yandex the service reports which links entered the index, which did not and which returned errors.

"After the September upgrade the checker completes the same lists in half the time, and the result is identical whether the request comes from the dashboard, the bot or the API. For an agency that means index verification stops being the slow step in reporting," noted Linda Bjorkvin.

An index check reflects the status of a URL at the moment of the request; search engines update their

results with a delay, and a page can enter or leave the index between two checks. SpeedyIndex guarantees the process rather than the outcome: links submitted for indexing are checked on day 7 (Google) and day 15 (Yandex), and under the Pay per Indexed model tokens are refunded automatically for links that are not indexed by the check date. The service does not promise that any given page will enter the index.

Availability

The bulk index checker and the indexing service are available in the [SpeedyIndex dashboard](#) after registration; free API access is included in every account. New accounts receive 200 free tokens for a trial. Indexing is offered under two models: Pay per Indexed at 100 tokens per link with an automatic refund for links not indexed by day 7 (Google) or day 15 (Yandex), and Pay per Submission at 30 tokens per link without refunds. The optional "already indexed" pre-check costs 3 tokens per link.

Quick facts

- **What changed:** the September 2026 infrastructure upgrade doubled the speed of SpeedyIndex bulk index checks (internal data, September 2026).
- **Coverage:** Google, Bing and Yandex in one checker; results per engine; up to 100,000 URLs in a single task.
- **API:** the REST API is free since the May 2026 launch and included in all accounts; checks are billed pay-as-you-go at \$0.0007 per URL, tokens do not expire.
- **No verification required:** any public URL can be checked, including third-party backlinks, without Google Search Console or Yandex Webmaster access.
- **From check to indexing:** unindexed URLs can be submitted for indexing under Pay per Indexed (100 tokens per link, automatic refund on day 7) or Pay per Submission (30 tokens per link).
- **Trial:** 100 free tokens for new accounts.

FAQ

What is a bulk index checker? A bulk index checker verifies whether a list of URLs is present in a search engine's index. Pages outside the index receive no organic search traffic, so the check shows which URLs can appear in search results at all. The SpeedyIndex checker accepts up to 100,000 URLs in a single task.

Which search engines does the SpeedyIndex checker cover? The checker reports index status in Google, Bing and Yandex. One uploaded list returns separate results for each engine.

Does index checking require Google Search Console verification? No. The SpeedyIndex checker works for any public URL, including pages on domains the user does not own, such as backlinks, guest posts and competitor pages. Google Search Console, by contrast, reports only on verified properties, covers about 2,000 URLs per property and returns data with a delay of 3 to 4 days.

Is the SpeedyIndex API free? Yes. API access has been free since the checker's launch in May 2026 and is included in all accounts, without monthly fees. Checks are billed pay-as-you-go at \$0.0007 per URL, and tokens do not expire. Indexing of links is a separate paid service under the Pay per Indexed and Pay per Submission models.

Can the checker verify backlinks from link building campaigns? Yes. Backlink lists can be

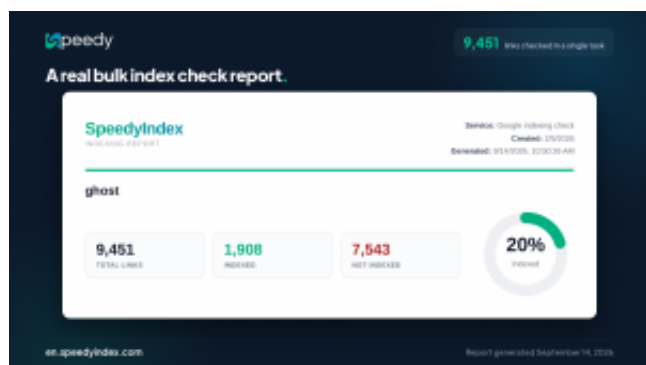
checked in bulk, and the report separates links on indexed pages from links on pages missing from the index. A backlink on an unindexed page passes no SEO value.

What happens if a page is not in the index? The URL can be submitted for indexing in the same account. Under Pay per Indexed the service checks the link on day 7 (Google) or day 15 (Yandex) and refunds tokens automatically if the link has not entered the index by that date.

How can a new user test the service? Registration includes 100 free tokens, which cover a trial of the checker and the indexing service. The service also offers free utilities: sitemap URL extraction and checks for redirects, noindex, 404 and 5xx errors.

About SpeedyIndex

SpeedyIndex is a link indexing and index checking service for SEO specialists, agencies and website owners. The service submits links for indexing in Google and Yandex, reports results on day 7 (Google) and day 15 (Yandex) and offers two payment models: Pay per Indexed, with an automatic token refund for links that are not indexed by the check date, and Pay per Submission. SpeedyIndex works with any public URLs without site verification and is available through the web dashboard, a Telegram bot @speedyindexbot, a Chrome extension and a REST API.
