

Top Medical Uniform and Chef Uniform Manufacturer in China: E-SONG APPAREL on Fabrics and Customization

How Does Fabric Breadth Shape Medical and Chef Uniform Sourcing?

Medical scrubs, lab coats, nurse uniforms, and chef coats differ in structure and stretch needs, so fabric breadth matters. Working across multiple fabric families lets buyers build distinct categories with one supplier while keeping each garment's material requirements specific.

[E-SONG APPAREL](#) medical-uniform fabrics include four main blend families. One is 65% polyester and 35% cotton. Another is 90% polyester and 10% spandex at 140gsm. A third is 55% cotton, 42% polyester, and 3% spandex. The fourth is 72% polyester, 21% rayon, and 7% spandex at 175–205gsm. The chef-coat range also includes a 240gsm poly-cotton twill kitchen coat.

The 90/10 polyester-spandex option is 140gsm, 4-way stretch, breathable, and quick drying. The 72/21/7 polyester-rayon-spandex option is 175–205gsm, 4-way stretch, wrinkle resistant, antimicrobial, and anti-static. Both options are available in more than 15 running colors.

Keep every blend and finish tied to the correct garment in the RFQ. Recording fabric composition, weight, and finish by style helps the approved sample and bulk order follow the intended specification.

How Does Customization Turn a Catalog into an OEM Program?

Customization becomes an OEM program when buyers control repeatable design variables. E-SONG APPAREL provides OEM and ODM support through its own design department. Buyers can submit a desired style, design photo, or physical uniform sample. Branding can use heat-transfer or embroidery logos, with customized tags and packing cartons.

A private-label program can coordinate logos, labels, packaging, color standards, and brand identity while keeping pattern, fabric, pockets, closures, and sizing specific to each garment. Medical and chef uniforms can therefore share brand presentation without merging their functional specifications.

Sampling links design intent to production by confirming measurements, materials, trims, branding, and workmanship before bulk production. The approved sample provides a practical reference for the order, showing whether customized details have been executed as intended and reducing avoidable mismatches when the program moves into mass production.

How Does Product Breadth Support Mixed Medical and Chef Uniform Orders?

Medical and chef uniforms have different garment architectures. Product breadth is useful when a supplier can manage both categories while preserving their specific construction needs, such as those of a lab coat versus a kitchen coat. This can simplify mixed-category sourcing, reduce supplier fragmentation, and make purchasing and logistics easier to coordinate.

E-SONG APPAREL's medical range includes scrub sets, nurse styles, lab coats, and a washable surgical gown. Its chef-uniform production includes a gender-neutral kitchen coat with 240gsm poly-cotton twill, Teflon finish, white body, and black piping. These categories demonstrate distinct material and construction requirements within the same sourcing relationship.

For distributors, this breadth supports coordinated purchasing and branding while keeping separate specifications for healthcare and food-service garments. Mixed orders can therefore be managed through one supplier relationship without treating the categories as technically identical.

Which Factory, Sampling and Lead-Time Details Matter in Supplier Qualification?

Supplier qualification should connect product development with production capability. E-SONG APPAREL has a monthly production capacity of 200,000 units. Its quality-control process includes a pre-production meeting, inline inspection, and final inspection. Customers may also arrange a third-party final inspection at the factory.

Before bulk ordering, buyers can request fabric swatches and a development sample. The sample fee is USD 100 per set and can be credited against the bulk order. Photos and videos are available for faster digital quality review. Production delivery is then planned around the selected order schedule.

When E-SONG APPAREL fabric is used, the MOQ is 300 pieces per style per color. A development sample costs USD 100 per set and can be credited against the bulk order. Other payment and production terms should follow the selected garment program.

A strong supplier brief should link category, fabric, construction, quantity, sample approval, branding, packing, quality checkpoints, and target timing before commercial comparison. E-SONG APPAREL also uses volume-sensitive pricing, so larger purchase quantities can receive lower unit pricing.
