Which Top-and-Pant Combinations Create Distinct Scrub-Set Options?

The V-neck and jogger combination can use a 90% polyester and 10% spandex fabric. It is 140gsm, 4-way stretch, breathable, and quick drying, with more than 15 running colors. E-SONG APPAREL can also support custom design and branding through heat-transfer or embroidery logos.

A collar-top and wide-cargo-pant product uses the same 90/10 polyester-spandex 4-way-stretch material family. This offers the same core minimum order quantity (MOQ), extensive size availability, deep customization support, and predictable lead-time structure. This pairing addresses the utility-focused segment of the healthcare workforce. This provides reinforced, multi-compartment storage capacity in the lower body while retaining the elevated stretch and easy-care performance of the baseline jogger style.

The wider range also includes Mandarin-collar tops with flare-leg pants and other nurse or medical configurations. These formats expand the assortment beyond standard V-neck sets. Distributors can use them to address different departmental dress codes and style preferences.

The useful comparison for commercial evaluation is the complete top-and-pant architecture, because each distinct pant silhouette and fabric property inherently belongs to its specific scrub-set configuration. Printed polyester-spandex combinations at a lighter 140gsm weight support a materially different Mandarin-collar and flared-pant direction. This lightweight printed configuration provides exceptional breathability and vivid color retention for pediatric or specialized care settings. This demonstrates the manufacturer's capacity to adapt substrate characteristics to the precise functional demands of the intended medical environment.

Private-label buyers should lock the exact fabric composition before final sample approval. Garment fit, drape, and pant shape should be evaluated on the intended bulk fabric. A substitute fabric can change tension, recovery, and pocket stability, so it may not represent the final set accurately.

How Do MOQ, Size Range and Custom Logo Terms Affect Line Planning?

When E-SONG APPAREL fabric is used, the MOQ is 300 pieces per style per color. Buyers can define

the scrub-set style, color, size run, and branding before production. Heat-transfer and embroidery logos are available within the company's OEM and ODM service.
