“Water damage and plumbing problems are often part of the same emergency, but homeowners have traditionally been forced to call two different companies,” said Dan Davies, president and founder of Water Damage Specialists. “By providing both services in-house, we can identify the source, make the repair, mitigate the damage and help restore the property with one coordinated team.”

### One Team From Plumbing Repair Through Property Restoration

Water Damage Specialists now provides [24/7 emergency plumbing](#) alongside its established water damage mitigation and restoration services.

Plumbing services include leak detection and repair, burst pipe repair, whole-home repiping, water heater repair and installation, drain cleaning and hydro jetting, sewer cleaning and repair, video sewer inspections, trenchless sewer repair, fixture installation, backflow testing, water treatment and filtration, gas line services and commercial plumbing.

For property owners dealing with active water damage, having both plumbing and restoration professionals within the same company can simplify an otherwise complicated process. Water Damage Specialists can locate and repair the source of the loss, extract standing water, dry affected building materials, document moisture conditions and complete necessary reconstruction.

The result is one crew, one timeline and one consistent documentation process rather than multiple contractors separately managing different portions of the same loss.

### Built for Utah’s Water Damage and Plumbing Challenges

Utah properties face plumbing risks that vary considerably by season and location. Winter cold snaps can lead to frozen and burst pipes, while spring mountain runoff can contribute to basement flooding. Hard water throughout Utah Valley can also accelerate wear on plumbing fixtures, water heaters and other components.

Older homes along the east bench and in historic neighborhoods may still contain aging galvanized plumbing or clay sewer laterals. Meanwhile, many homes constructed during Utah's rapid growth in the 2000s and 2010s are reaching an age when original water heaters, fixtures, softeners and supply components increasingly require repair or replacement.

Water Damage Specialists combines its local restoration experience with plumbing expertise to help identify and resolve these problems before additional property damage occurs.

"Having spent years responding to floods, we know how quickly a relatively small plumbing failure can become a major property loss," said Robert Hortin, general manager of Water Damage Specialists. The company also assists customers through adjuster inspections, supplements and claim disputes when additional damage is uncovered.
