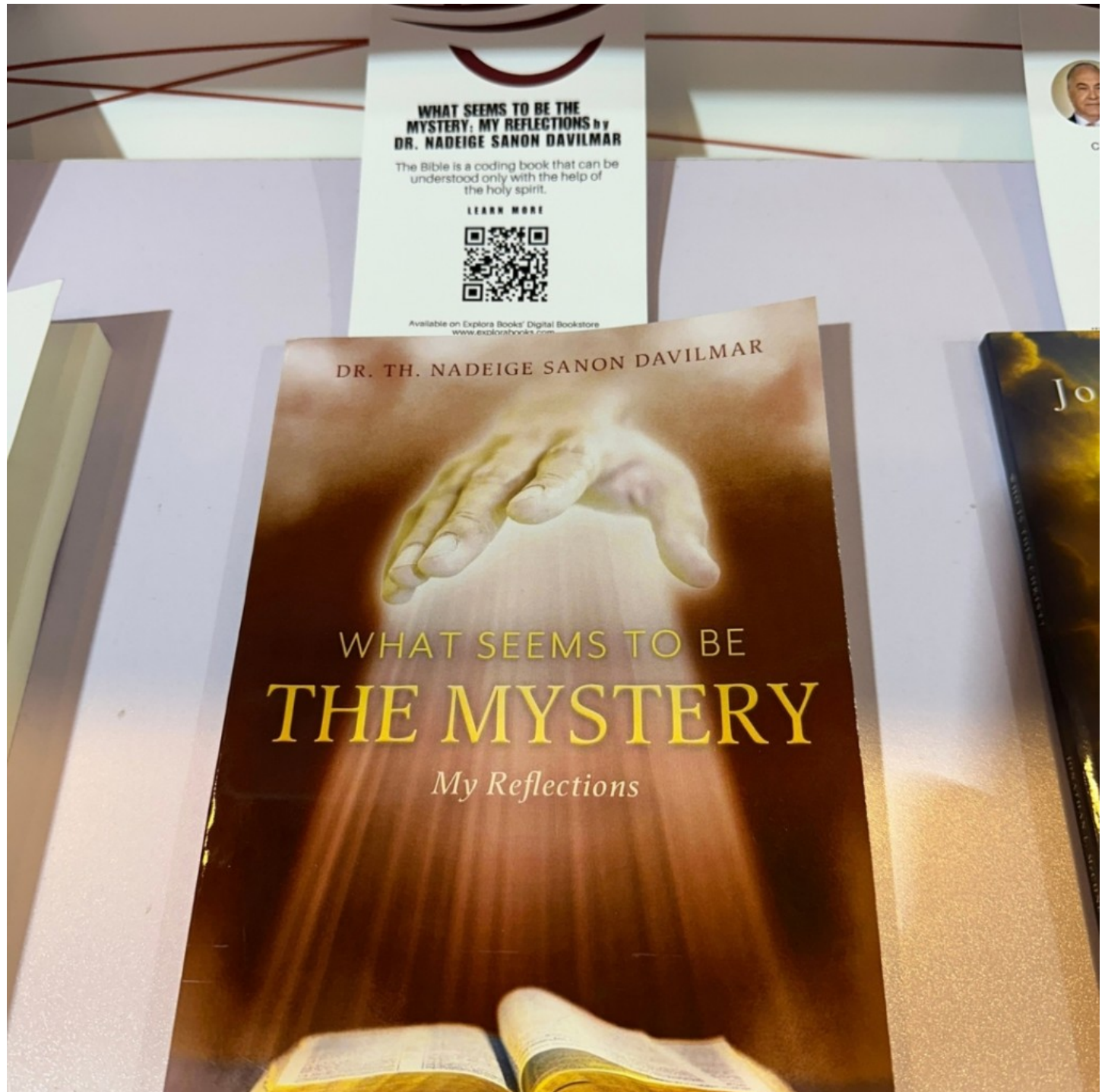


‘What Seems to Be the Mystery’ Invites Deeper Reflection on Scripture at BIBF 2026

Explora Books presented ‘What Seems to Be the Mystery: My Reflections’ by Dr. Nadeige Sanon Davilmar at the 2026 Beijing International Book Fair (BIBF), held June 17–21 at the China National Convention Center (CNCC) in Beijing.

Published in May 2026 by Trilogy Christian Publishing, the book treats the Bible as what Davilmar calls a “coding book”—a text whose hidden truths can only be unlocked through faith and the Holy Spirit.

“I am sure, like myself, there are many other people who are searching for the truth. And this book is like an opening to find the essence of the Bible,” Davilmar writes.

Rather than presenting definitive answers, Davilmar frames faith as an ongoing search, guided by the proverb, “From the clashes of ideas gushes the flow of light.” That perspective distinguishes the book from more traditional devotional works, inviting readers to engage scripture through reflection and to discover its value through continued inquiry rather than certainty.

Davilmar spent decades as a nurse at Kings County Hospital in New York while serving in ministry alongside her husband, Pastor Clovis Davilmar. That combination of clinical experience and pastoral life shapes the book’s perspective, which reads less as a theological argument than as an invitation extended to readers wherever they find themselves in their spiritual journey.

The fair’s 40th-anniversary edition brought together over 1,700 exhibitors from 82 countries and regions, with the United Arab Emirates serving as Guest of Honor under the theme “Community and People.” Bringing together publishers and readers from diverse countries, cultures, and traditions, BIBF provided a fitting setting for a book whose central message embraces dialogue as a path toward greater understanding.

Even amid programming focused on artificial intelligence, digital publishing, and international rights, *What Seems to Be the Mystery* offered a quieter kind of exchange—one built on reflection rather than resolution. In doing so, it echoed the fair’s broader emphasis on fostering dialogue and strengthening the communities that publishing serves.
