Community at the Core

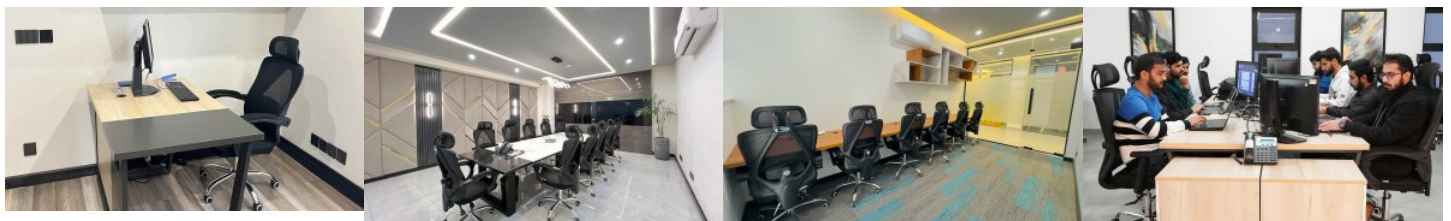
